

NOTIFICATION TO MEMBERS – EDEN GOLF CLUB VOLUNTEER WORKS ON GOLF COURSE

It has come to Club Management's attention that in recent weeks, a select group of volunteers have been undertaking unauthorised and unplanned works across sections of the club's golf course and garden areas outside giving formal notification of those project to Club management and in many instances the Course maintenance staff contractor.

As much as the positive intention of those members efforts are to be appreciated, ANY volunteer works performed on the club's property must in the first instance be registered and confirmed with the Course Superintendent and Eden Golf Club Committee prior to being undertaken and the nature of those projects/ works being proposed so as to NOT contradict work plans already identified by the official volunteer organising committee who is presently responsible to plan and oversee volunteer works on course.

There are very clear grounds why this ruling applies,

Firstly, any volunteer works that result in the deployment of the Clubs Greens
Division Contractor's time, equipment or labour support **must be approved by Club Managemen**t prior to those works being performed. E.g. Removal of tree litter, timber stockpiles etc..

Secondly, and more importantly, the club's public liability insurance policy is limited to those members officially recorded as an 'Approved Nominated Volunteer". This process provides adequate insurance cover should they incur accident or injury whilst performing works on the club's course.
