PGA GRANT

SLOW PLAY

Slow play is a common issue that can affect everyone's enjoyment of the game, particularly on competition days.

To help keep the pace moving smoothly, please be mindful of a few key practices.

First, always be ready to take your shot when it's your turn.

On the greens, read your putt while others are preparing theirs.

Please complete your scorecard at the next tee, not at the green.

Most Importantly, be aware of your position on the course and ensure you keep up with the group ahead.

Golf etiquette requires slower groups to wave faster groups through, don't be

embarrassed to wave people through.

Nobody really likes feeling hassled, and nobody really likes being held up.

By complying with these key practices, everyone will have enjoyment of their game.

RULE 6.2b(6)

Anytime a player's ball is inside the teeing area, the player may move the ball to another spot within the teeing area and play it from A TEE without penalty.

For example, a player makes his first stroke from the teeing area barely making contact with the ball and the ball comes to rest in the ground in the teeing area or remains on the tee.

Since the ball is in the teeing area the player may play the ball as it lies or even though the ball is in play may move the ball to another spot within the teeing area without penalty.

The player may also place the ball on a tee or adjust the height of the tee the ball is resting on.
