RULE OF THE MONTH 15.1B

If your removal of a loose impediment causes your ball to move, your ball must be replaced on its original spot.

If your ball had been at rest anywhere except the green or in the teeing area you get a ONE-stroke penalty.

The most common situation for this is moving a stick that your ball is resting on and the ball moves. Replace the ball and unfortunately, you have to add a stroke. Be careful when you move sticks around your ball.
