VOLUNTEER WORKERS



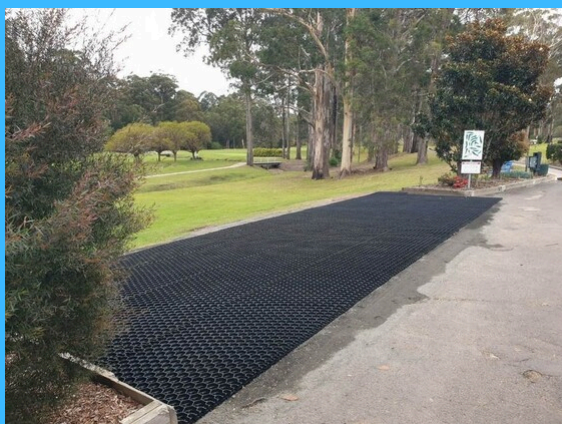
A crew put in 40 meters of diamond grid on the 17th tee area. There is a plan for some around the 16th tee area but we need to wait for drying weather.
