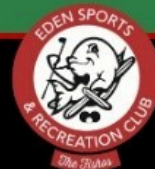

RULE OF THE MONTH

Dropping your ball from a path

When dropping from a path or other immovable obstruction, many people mistakenly believe that they're entitled to a perfect lie and line because they don't really understand, or forget, exactly what it is they're taking relief from.

You are only getting relief from that specific immovable obstruction or abnormal course condition, so if the relief area measured from your nearest point of complete relief takes you unavoidably into thick rough, a bush or behind a tree, that is where you have to drop if you elect to take free relief as there is no free relief from such elements in the general area.

Many golfers will say, "Oh, I can't drop there because I'll get a terrible lie in the rough, so I'll drop over here in this shorter grass."

But you don't get free relief from thick rough, trees, bushes, dreadful lies etc in the general area so if that is where the relief area measured from your nearest point of complete relief takes you, that is where you must drop if you decide to take free relief.

Remember, it's 'nearest' not 'nicest' point of complete relief - the location of that spot is not negotiable and you are not guaranteed a perfect lie or line.
